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Tuition and fees are due at the time of registration to secure a place in class. Fees must be paid or authorized by a third-party sponsor prior to the first day of class.

Students are responsible for scheduling the State Tested Nursing Assistant (STNA) certification exam after successfully completing the program.

Class Hours

Classes are Monday through Friday (*and occasional weekend hours*) between the hours of 8:00am and 8:30pm. Class hours will vary; students should refer to the program syllabus. Attendance at clinicals is a mandatory requirement for successful completion of this program. All students must provide proof of a physical examination that has been within 30 days of the start of clinical hours.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Students with any past felony conviction may be disqualified from taking the STNA exam due to certain restrictions from the certification entity. For more information, a student should discuss his/her individual circumstances with the instructor and/or testing entity.

PAYMENT AND REFUND POLICY

Payment is accepted in the form of cash, check (payable to Tri-County Career Center), MasterCard or Visa. Registration and payment must be made together, either in person, by mail, or by phone if paying by credit card.

Students utilizing the “third party” sponsors (agency or business) must provide verification/billing authorization with registration materials.

Fees paid are fully refundable through the third day of class. Once books are issued to the student, the fees paid for books are not refundable. One hundred percent (100%) of the tuition and fees are due at the onset of class and there will be no refunds after the third full day of class. In the event that class is delayed or canceled, all fees paid will be refunded in full by the Adult Center. Refunds due to students will be processed no later than 45 days from the date of determination.

All student charges including tuition, books/supplies, and testing fees are the responsibility of each student. Sources of funding provided through third party sponsors will be applied to student charges. In the event that sponsor supported funds are reduced or denied, the student must pay the “balance due” amount.

FINANCIAL AID SOURCES

Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD) is the State of Ohio agency that partners with Ohioans with disabilities to achieve quality employment and independence. Call 800-282-4536 for the nearest local OOD office. In the Athens area call 740-592-4411.

Ohio Means Jobs – Please contact your caseworker at the Ohio Means Jobs center in your home county. If you do not have a caseworker, feel free to visit or call your local ONE STOP Office available in each county. You need not be on public assistance to receive some types of Ohio Means Jobs education sponsorship. This course is WIOA approved. Funds may be available through the ONE STOP offices in your county for youth, adult, and dislocated workers.

Community Action Agencies sometimes have education funding sources; contact the agency for your county.

Dislocated workers (“Lay-Offs”) may be eligible for funding through agencies or employers.

NOTE: It is the student’s responsibility to contact these sources and determine eligibility for a particular program. Be aware that it can take a long period to complete the application process. Enrollment is on a first-come (registered and paid), first serve basis. Please allow plenty of time to get the required paperwork in order.
