The Nursing Assistant program is a 110-clock hour, 3-week certificate program.** Students will participate in a clinical experience in both a home healthcare site and a long-term care facility. Modules are also offered for individuals who do not require the full training program. Students will be preparing for entry-level employment as a Nursing Assistant or Home Health Aide as they study:

- Basic nursing skills
- Infection control
- Personal care skills
- Mental health and social service needs
- Basic restorative services
- Resident's rights
- First Aid and CPR Pro
- Employment skills
